

N Koreans Irate over Salute to S. Korea Flag

Apparently, London Olympic organizers failed to recognize the difference between a South Korean and North Korean flag. Hence, they required North Korean soccer players to salute the South Korean flag before a match.

The Houston Chronicle reports that, "London Olympic organizers mistakenly displayed the South Korean flag on a jumbo screen instead of North Korea's before a soccer match Wednesday, prompting the North Koreans to refuse to take the field for nearly an hour."

The flag snafu occurred during player introductions when a North Korean player was introduced along with a visual of the South Korean flag.
