

Eco-Terrorist Paul Watson Jumps Bail

Eco-terrorist, Paul Watson recently jumped bail in Germany. So, will former bail bondsman, Dallas County District Attorney Craig Watkins launch a fugitive search for justice on him? Or could Mr. Watson be headed towards Anaheim to participate in riots? These are some of the questions that inquiring minds want to know.

According to the BBC News, "Sea Shepherd founder Paul Watson flees Germany; A Canadian marine conservationist has jumped bail in Germany and disappeared."

The founder of the US-based anti-whaling terrorist organization, Sea Shepherd, Paul Watson, was taken into custody in Germany in May after Costa Rica issued a warrant for his arrest.

Paul Shepherd, who is recognized as the al-Qaeda environmentalist, faces charges of endangering the crew of a Costa Rican ship that was fishing for sharks in 2002.

As reported by the BBC, "a Frankfurt court has ordered his re-arrest. But his lawyer was quoted as saying, "he has left Germany for an unknown destination."

As a fugitive of justice, Paul Shepherd will be placed on the US State Department's "No-Fly List" for engaging in terrorist activities.
