

Venezuela Refinery Fire Rages Out of Control

Vice President Elias Jaua of Venezuela announced that fire at the nation's largest oil refinery has spread. According to the BBC News, "he said a third tank was ablaze following Saturday's explosion, which is now known to have killed 48 people."
