

Obama Wins Marxist Endorsement from Chavez

Venezuelan President Hugo Chavez, a self-proclaimed Marxist, has just announced his glowing endorsement of President Barack Obama's \$1 billion re-election bid for the White House. He believes they can unite as comrades in arms for the greater good of a global socialist order.
