

French Pirates Terrorize British Scallops Boats

Apparently, Somali pirates are coming to France to raid British scallops boats. Yet, the British refuse to be intimidated by militant French fishermen. According to the Daily Mail of London, "proudly clutching the Union flag, the crew of the British scallop dredger Van Dijk stand firm in the face of sabre-rattling French.
